Early Voting for March 5 Presidential Preference Primary & County Primaries Concludes Tuesday, Feb. 27

GRUNDY, COUNTY Tenn. – The Tennessee Secretary of State's office and Garry Miller want to remind all Grundy, County voters that Tuesday, Feb. 27 is the final day to cast a ballot during the early voting period for the March 5 Presidential Preference Primary and County Primaries.

"Early voting concludes on Feb. 27, but there is still time for all registered Grundy voters to cast their ballots ahead of Super Tuesday," said Garry Miller.

The ballot for the March 5 Presidential Preference Primary was certified and set in December of 2023 so some candidates who have suspended their presidential campaign will still appear on the ballot. Voters will not only be selecting their preferred presidential candidate, but they will also be selecting delegates if voting in the Republican Primary, and Justin Harris in first district school board.

"If you are a registered Tennessee voter and you have not yet cast your ballot during the early voting period, now is the time," said Secretary of State Tre Hargett. "Early voting provides a safe, secure process for registered voters to let their voices be heard before Election Day."
